REPUBLICAN PARTY OF GUAM ATTEND 2024 RNC IN WISCONSIN

Delegates from Guam to participate in historic process to elect Party Nominee for President of the United States

The Republican Party of Guam announces that its Delegates have arrived in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to participate in the 2024 Republican National Convention (2024 RNC). The Nine Delegates and Six Alternate Delegates have been closely working with their State Party counterparts from across the Country on the Platform, Credentials, Rules, and Permanent Organization Committees over the past several weeks which culminate in the election of the Party's Presidential Candidate on Thursday, July 18, 2024 local time at the Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee.

The Delegates were elected to represent the Party during the Guam State Convention on March 16, 2024.

“This has been a very dynamic process,” said Republican Party of Guam Chairman Shawn Gumataotao. “I am pleased with the effort of all of our Guam Delegates-each playing a key role in setting the tone for the next four years with the adoption of the Party Platform and being instrumental in the process to name our Party Nominee for President of the United States of America.”

The 2024 RNC opens on July 15, 2024 (July 16, 2024 Guam Time). The Platform of the Republican Party is expected to be adopted in the first of five sessions with the Presidential nominee to be voted upon and presented in the final session on July 18, 2024 local time.

“This week, Milwaukee will be front-and-center on the national and world stage as the Convention attracts upwards of 50,000 delegates, staff, volunteers, security, media, and other organizations that will undoubtedly create a significant and positive economic impact for the community, both short and long-term,” said Gumataotao. “The 2024 Republican National Convention will undoubtedly continue to build the energy and momentum necessary to drive Former President Donald J. Trump to victory this fall.”
